### ***Before the Lesson***

- ✓ Hang the days of the week flashcards in the correct order.
- ✓ Hang the English Adventure Map at the front of the classroom.
- ✓ Arrange the flashcards in piles. Place them on the table, according to topics.
- ✓ Cut the brown paper or poster board into the shape of a house and write on the top: **Class \_\_\_\_\_, Our Homes.**
- ✓ Cut blank pieces of A4 paper in half so you have enough sheets for the whole class.
- ✓ Have pupils' name cards ready.
