Objectives	Materials and Songs
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • involving pupils in the process of planning a class party - pupils share responsibility for different activities and products • giving pupils a sense of pride in the work they have done and their accomplishments 	<p>Materials</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Max the puppet • all books studied • strips, colored paper and stickers to decorate party hats (one for each pupil) • large sheet of brown paper with five columns traced • flashcards representative of each book and story (monkey, frog, monster, Goldilocks, classroom objects) • pupils' namecards • days of the week flashcards • welcome sign • cardboard for puzzle game <p>Storybooks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Five Little Monkeys, The Frog Family, Goldilocks, Not Now Bernard, We Can Share at School <p>Songs and Chants</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Good Morning School (song #1.37) • H-A-P-P-Y (song #1.24) • Five Little Monkeys Chant (song #1.16) • Goldilocks (song #1.33) • Where Is Father Frog (song #1.23) • I Love You (song #1.20) • I Am Special (song #1.35) • Max Is a Friend of Mine (song #1.36)

Before the Lesson

- ✓ Prepare all material, including cardboard strips to use as hats and materials for decoration.
- ✓ Prepare cardboard for puzzle game.
- ✓ Prepare a hat in advance and show it to the class as an example.
- ✓ On a large piece of brown paper, trace five columns (each column wide enough for pupils to paste in pictures from their Activity Book).
- ✓ Prepare a welcome sign.
- ✓ Prepare equipment for playing songs.
